HOW TO: PROMOTE OUR TOURNAMENTS

- Go to usseniorpickleball.com or <u>click here for a list of all USSP</u> <u>certified tournaments.</u>
- See which tournaments are coming to your Zone, Region and local area and start spreading the word by:
 - Posting on local pickleball Facebook pages
 - Talking to friends and players at your local courts
 - Visiting local clubs and courts

Be sure to highlight the reasons that USSP tournaments are different from the rest:

- Senior- Friendly play with skill levels grouped into 5-year age brackets.
- Round Robin/Pool Play
- A point-award system for USSP members with \$20,000 in prize value awarded annually.







HOW TO: REGISTER FOR OUR TOURNAMENTS

- <u>Become a USSP member to ensure you get a \$10 discount at all of</u> our tournaments!
- Pick the tournament you want to attend.
- Make sure your Pickleball.com (or pickleballtournaments.com)
 account has US Senior Pickleball listed as one of your association
 memberships. This will ensure you receive your \$10 discount/rebate
 for all USSP tournaments.
 - To do this:
 - Go to pickleball.com
 - Click on Your name/ "My Profile" in the upper right hand corner
 - Click on "Edit Profile"
 - Click on "Association Memberships", then "Add Membership"
 - Enter US Senior Pickleball and your USSP Membership number.
 - There is a lookup function if you dont recall your USSP number.
 - Once you have added US Senior Pickleball to your pickleball.com profile, you can follow the registration steps on pickleball.com for your selected tournament.







OUR 2025 CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

HOW TO: GROW USSP MEMBERSHIP ITS AS EASY AS 1,2,3!

- Familiarize yourself with the numerous USSP membership
 benefits (next page). If you're on Facebook, join the US Senior Pickleball Group as well as the US Senior Pickleball
 Ambassador's Group for current grassroots and tournament event information.
- Talk with local senior-aged pickleball friends about why you
 support our organization and enjoy being a member. Help us become recognized in your local area by posting about our grassroots events and upcoming tournaments on social media.
- Volunteer at local pickleball events and let folks know about our organization and what we do. Wear your USSP gear, and let folks know you're a USSP Ambassador. We can provide you with flyers and some giveaway items such as stickers and pencils to help get the word out.





When new USSP members join and list you as a referral you'll get credit toward great ambassador rewards!

HOW TO: SIGN UP NEW USSP MEMBERS AND GET REFERRAL CREDIT

WHEN YOU HAVE SOMEONE READY TO JOIN USSP, HERE'S WHAT TO DO:

- Go to usseniorpickleball.com on a computer or mobile device. Click on "Join Now" on the home page.
- 2 Select Membership Length (Annual, 3-Year or 5-Year).
- Have the new member enter their contact information and ask them to select your name in the "Referred By" dropdown.

 *If you are a new ambassador and your name is not listed, please email tara@usseniorpickleball.com to be added to the dropdown.
- On the next page, have the new member enter their email address and chose a username and password for their account.
- On the final page, have the new member complete their payment
 information. They do not need a paypal account to complete the
 registration and can checkout as a guest. An email will be automatically
 sent to the new member with their new USSP membership number.
- Go to Pickleball.com and have the member update their profile and add
 USSP as one of their association memberships. They will need their USSP number for this. This will ensure they receive their \$10 discount/rebate for our tournaments.

The registration is now complete!



HOW TO:

PLAN A "TRY PICKLEBALL FOR FREE" GRASSROOTS EVENT

If you live in a community where you'd like to expand pickleball play to seniors who are brand new to the game, here's how to plan a beginner clinic in your area.

1. Find a Facility

- Connect with local courts or pickleball clubs in your area, tell them about USSP. Ask if they have a free beginner or trial class that is specific for seniors. Ask if they would be interested in planning a small class during their least busy time, and USSP would help market it to seniors in the local community to bring more business to their courts. Seeif they have used paddles for new players to use during the lesson.
- Plan a date and time at least 45 days in advance to allow time to market the event and have optimal attendance. Typically pickleball clubs have a weekday lull during work hours, this is often an ideal time to host a clinic for senior players who are retirees.
- If court time is not free/donated by the facility, find out hourly court rental prices.
- Confirm the facilities: Check for amenities like parking, restrooms, and seating for spectators or players during breaks.

2. Find Instructors

- Look for certified pickleball instructors or experienced players who can teach the basics to beginners. Ask the facility you are using if they have instructors who would be interested in teaching the clinic.
- Discuss availability, compensation, and expectations: Many instructors will donate their time to teach a 1-time clinic if they might have the ability to teach continued (paid) lessons with the players in the future.

3. Contact your local USSP Zone Director for guidance on financials.

• Once you have an idea of the total cost of the event (any court rental fees, instructor fees, additional items like light snacks or water bottles), email your Zone director with your plan for the event. They have a budget to work with for each zone and will work to get you the compensation for the fees in advance of the event.

4. Post Flyers and Market the Event on Facebook and in person

- Contact USSP's digital Media Director, Charlott at charlott@usseniorpickleball.com with event details. She can design a flyer for you to post on facebook pages, or print to have at the courts.
- Share on Facebook: Post the flyer on the facility's Facebook page and community groups. Use captions like "Are you 50+ and Ready to try Pickleball? Join our beginner clinic!" Include hashtags like #PickleballClinic, #SeniorPickleball, or #LearnPickleball to increase visibility. USSP will market the event to our members and on our social media as well.

5. Have Players Sign Up Ahead of Time

• Decide on a maximum participant number depending on how many courts you will be using. Decide the best way to have players register. Often a facility will handle the sign-ups on their website or by phone.

5. Host the Clinic

- Prepare the courts: Arrive early to set up the courts, arrange paddles and balls, and set out any USSP/ Humana brochures or giveaways.
- Welcome players: Greet participants as they arrive, introduce the instructors, and tell them about USSP.
- Keep it fun and engaging: Ensure the clinic is interactive, with demonstrations, drills, and plenty of time for players to practice and ask questions.

6. Thank Players and Encourage USSP Membership/More Pickleball

- After the clinic: Send a thank-you message to the participants expressing gratitude for their attendance and participation. Encourage them to become USSP members and partake in upcoming events.
- Invite them to sign up for future lessons: Let them know about upcoming clinics or private lessons available at the facility to continue improving their skills.
- Post pictures from the event on the USSP Ambassador FB page and send a recap page to tara@usseniorpickleball.com

By following these steps, you'll be able to host a successful ambassador beginner pickleball clinic and help players get started in the game!

HOW TO:

PLAN A "SENIOR OPEN PLAY" GRASSROOTS 12 EVENT SERIES



If you want to let local clubs and courts know about USSP, a great way is to approach pickleball facilities about having US Senior Pickleball sponsor a Senior Open Play each week, here's how you can do it:

- 1. Create a simple document or email that outlines what US Senior Pickleball is, how sponsoring open play time for senior players can benefit the facility, and the specifics of what you're offering.
 - Details to include:
 - What is being offered: US Senior Pickleball would like to sponsor a weekly open play session exclusively for senior players over 50 if the facility does not already offer this.
 - Cost: Explain that USSP will offer the facility a small stipend of up to \$500 each month for 3 months (up to \$1500 total), helping to reduce the usual cost for senior players.
 - Benefits to the facility: Highlight how the facility will gain exposure through your organization, possibly bring in new players, and increase foot traffic.
 - Benefits to USSP: Ask the facility to hang a USSP banner, promote USSP to their senior members, and ask to have a USSP/Humana information table available during the open play hour(s).
- 2. Research Potential Facilities and Reach Out
- Check their schedule: Inquire if there are open time slots during the week for your program without conflicting with other events. Weekday mornings are often good.
- Send an email or call: Start by introducing yourself and US Senior Pickleball. Mention that you'd like to discuss an opportunity for the facility to hold a sponsored weekly open play time for seniors.
- Ask for a meeting: Request a time to discuss the proposal in person or over the phone to give a more detailed explanation. At this time you can reach out to your USSP Zone director and see if they would like to join you for the meeting if they are able.
- 3. Present the Idea to the facility
- Once you have a chance to talk with the facility, present your idea for senior open play.
- Explain the benefits:
 - For the facility: It's a great way to attract senior players and encourage more people to use their courts.
 - For senior players: They'll have a dedicated time to play, which builds a sense of community. They will also have discounted play time, offering an affordable decreased rate.
 - For US Senior Pickleball: This is an initiative to promote pickleball among seniors, so the facility will have the backing of a trusted organization.
- Discuss logistics: Talk about scheduling, payment of the stipend, and how the event will be managed each week. Explain that the stipend is made possible by Humana, the sponsor of the USSP ambassador program.
- Explain the 3-month timeframe: Let them know that there will be opportunity to expand the open play offering beyond 3 months if players enjoy the program and become USSP members.
- 4.. Finalize the Agreement
- Once the facility is interested, draft a simple agreement outlining the terms: the stipend amount, duration (3 months), scheduling, and any other details you've agreed upon. Send it to your Zone Director who will arrange for a check to be sent to the facility.
- 5. Promote the Open Play Time, Attend and Have Fun!
- Work with the facility and USSP marketing to promote the event through flyers, social media, and email newsletters. If you are able to attend the events, promote USSP membership and our tournaments. Take photos and, most importantly, have a great time!

By following these steps, you'll be able to successfully pitch the idea to pickleball facilities and help them create more affordable senior programing in their weekly schedules as well as promote USSP!





CONNECTING WITH Humana. FOR LOCAL EVENTS




When you schedule a newly planned USSP Grassroots event such as a beginner clinic or senior open play, USSP will send the event information to a Humana Community Marketing Executive (CME) in your local area.









Humana representatives are available to answer questions and make connections with the players but will never be at events as "salespeople." They can take contact information if players would like more info, but they are mainly present to establish friendly connections with the pickleball world.

Our USSP Senior Brand Ambassador program, and the events we are able to create, are made possible by the generous sponsorship from Humana. We would love to have their presence at as many Senior Brand Ambassadorled events and USSP tournaments as possible!

US Senior Pickleball Ambassador Rewards Program 2025



To thank our Senior Brand Ambassadors

Level 1 Rewards:

Level 5 Rewards:

When an ambassador Registers 100 new USSP members:

When an ambassador brings in 500+ new USSP members:

AMBASSADOR FAQS

- Do you have to be a senior to join USSP?
- This is a common misconception! NO! You do not need to be 50 years old to join or support USSP. You DO need to be 50+ to play in our USSP Championship Series tournaments, but people of any age can be members, and ambassadors!
- How can I see who the other ambassadors are and which grassroots events are happening in my area?

A Shared file with an ambassador roster and event calendar will be sent to every ambassador via email.

Do I have to pay out of pocket to hold local senior pickleball grassroots events?

Definitely not! If you are planning a local senior clinic or event, contact your Zone Director, they will be able to invoice USSP so all predetermined event expenses are covered ahead of time.

How can I get flyers, banners or giveaways to market USSP to my local area? How do I get a shirt or other USSP swag?

We are working to have Senior Brand Ambassador section of the USSP website where you can download flyers, request marketing material and small giveaways such as stickers for events, and share photos.

Until that is up and running, please contact your Zone Director for banners, Charlott for event flyers, and Tara for USSP brochures, paddle donations, and giveaway items.


